*(These Awards are open to all OVAHA members in good standing dues paid for 2011 and no outstanding dues to the club).*

### **Award Presentation**

All awards earned in the OVAHA awards program will be presented at the Awards Banquet. Any awards not claimed by a recipient at the banquet will be held by the Points Chairperson and upon payment of pertinent postage costs, will be sent to the recipient of the award. All awards unclaimed after 30 days will be unavailable.

Upon receiving a perpetual award the recipient will be required to sign a receipt acknowledging that they have received the award. It is the recipients responsibility to return the award to the current Club President 45 days prior to the High Point Award Banquet. If the award is not returned the recipient is responsible for the cost of the award as presented.

2. **POINTS MAY BE SUBMITTED TO A MAXIMUM OF 5 SHOWS.** Either/or non-recognized/schooling shows and AHA recognized shows. The Tulip Show counts as an AHA Class A Show. Points will be based on placing in class. (i.e. place 1<sup>st</sup> in class in Class A show; Tulip or Empire receives 10 points).
3. **For any show, in any division, only TWO regular performance classes and ONE championship class will count towards High Score Awards. (ie 3 classes/division/show)**
4. **OVERALL HIGH SCORE ADULT AMATEUR OWNER AWARD:** Will be awarded to the Adult Amateur exhibitor accumulating the most points in AAOTH, AOTH, AAOTR, AOTR, OR ANY ATR CLASSES on one horse. Points accumulated in Open division classes will not count towards this award. To be eligible for this award the horse must be owned by the Adult Amateur or a member of his/her immediate family. Points accumulated in the amateur classes MAY count towards the horse's overall score and/or to the horse's score in the individual performance divisions of these awards
5. **OVERALL HIGH SCORE HORSE:** One award given to the highest scoring purebred and one award given to the highest scoring partbred. (This class includes both performance and conformation class points.)
6. **OVERALL HIGH SCORE YOUTH 17 YRS AND UNDER AWARD:** Geared towards the competitor rather than the horse and includes Showmanship, Equitation and all performance classes where entry is restricted to exhibitors 17 years of age and under. Youth Exhibitor High Score Award will be given to the youth exhibitor accumulating the most points in JOTH, JOTR, JTR, AOTH, AOTR and ATR or any class that a YOUTH exhibitor 17 years of age and under (including walk/trot or jog) would enter. Points that will not count towards this award include those accumulated in Open division classes even though a Youth Exhibitor rides the horse. The points earned by the horse in any Youth classes MAY count towards the horse's overall score and/or to the horse's score in the individual performance divisions of these awards.
7. **YOUTH WALK/TROT AWARD:** Open to all OVAHA Youth members age 10 years and under. Qualifying classes will include any classes; where the exhibitor is NOT required to canter or lope. Points won in Youth Showmanship 17 and under will count towards this award.

8. **LEADLINE :** Open to youth exhibitor's age 6 years and under. The exhibitor, does not have to be an OVAHA member. The horse ridden must belong to an OVAHA member.

***Entries must be POSTMARKED by March 16, 2012.***

***You must submit your points in order to qualify for these awards.***

**Competitive Trail Ride/Endurance**

1. Competitors earn 1 point per mile for any completed ride.
2. In addition, points are awarded for each weight division and novice division, where appropriate, as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup>	5
2 <sup>nd</sup>	4
3 <sup>rd</sup>	3
4 <sup>th</sup>	2
5 <sup>th</sup>	1

3. Additional points for Overall Champion and Reserve are as follows:
